| Step | Stage                 | What happens                                    |
|------|-----------------------|---|
| 1    | Showroom visit        | Explore displays, colours and finish options.   |
| 2    | Design brief          | Talk through how the kitchen needs to work.     |
| 3    | Measure & survey      | Record dimensions, services and key details.    |
| 4    | 2D & 3D design        | Create a layout you can clearly visualise.      |
| 5    | Quote & specification | Present kitchen, fitting and extras clearly.    |
| 6    | Final checks          | Confirm colours, handles, appliances and dates. |
| 7    | Installation          | Coordinate fitting, trades and handover.        |

Tip: bring as much detail as you can. Better information creates a sharper design and a more accurate quote.

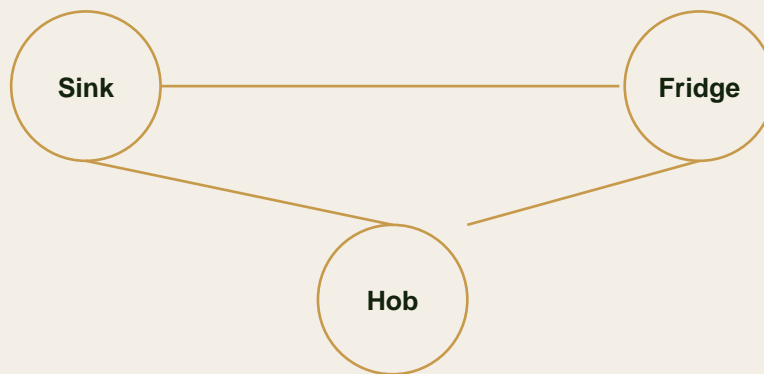

# Layout Planning

Strong kitchen planning starts with the relationship between preparation, cooking and washing zones. Keep routes simple with useful worktop either side of the sink and hob.

| Kitchen shape      | Best used for  |
|--------------------|--|
| Galley             | Efficient for narrow rooms with a clear cabinet run. |
| L-shaped           | Great for open-plan rooms and corner storage.        |
| U-shaped           | Maximum storage and worktop space.                   |
| Island / peninsula | Adds seating, prep space and visual impact.          |



The working triangle: keep movement easy between sink, hob and fridge.

# Room Measurements

Measure in millimetres where possible. Mark windows, doors, boiler, stop tap, radiator, sockets, gas point and waste position.
